The plan outlines the project's steps to purchase and test 12 electric buses along with their charging utilities. The buses will begin service in 2023, with the main goal being to determine the buses' synergy with charging different brands' charging equipment over a 12 month period. BDE will provide SAI's low voltage switchgear and JST's medium voltage transformer to support the entire power station.
